YOU WILL NEED SUITABLE BOOTS FOR WALKING AND
HARD HATS WILL BE PROVIDED.

PARK AT THE VILLAGE HALL AND TAKE THE FOOTPATH BELOW, OFF THE MAIN ROAD TO EAST PAST FISHING LAKE. KEEP WOODS TO YOUR LEFT UNTIL YOU GET TO THE STILE INTO THE WOODS. THE MOUND IS BY THE END OF THE BIG LAKE. NGR SO 813655.
